#### Harassment:



Staff has the ability to contact local law enforcement, and can provide escort, or otherwise assist those feeling they have experienced harassment to ensure they feel safe for the duration of the convention. Also, and we can not stress this enough, COSPLAY IS NOT CONSENT!

#### Cosplay weapons and props:

No functional weapons of any kind are allowed. DO NOT BRING REAL SWORDS, GUNS, OR ANY TYPE OF AUTHENTIC WEAPON TO THE SHOW. ONLY PROPS ARE ALLOWED. Simulated or costume weapons are allowed as part of a costume. No projectile weapons (including but not limited to airsoft or paintball weapons) allowed. All realistic guns MUST have an orange tip. No metal weapons of any kind. All simulated or costume weapons will be inspected by convention staff who may refuse entry at their discretion. Weapon safety decisions by staff are final. Participants found to be in violation of these, or any other rules will be subject to removal from the con. Please understand that we will always err on the side of safety.

There are trashcans throughout the event for your convenience. Please deposit all trash into the designated cans. If you see trash around, please do us a solid and either pick it up or tell a staff member and they will take care of it. Let's keep it clean.




#### 12:30 - 1:30 STEAM Character Design: Art Edition

#### Lucy Wouldn't Lie

Written & Directed by Erin Welch. Morbid secrets surface between two friends in this dark comedy short film.

#### The Prize of Ocean City

Written & Directed by Holden Conner. Three best friends go to Ocean City and learn the true value of a day at the beach.

#### The Ballad of Pop and Corn

Written, produced, and directed by Myah Stokes. The Ballad of Pop and Corn is a puppetry short film that depicts the exploration of boardwalk scraps who have a newfound life. Disguised as humans to join as one, the film aims to follow the adventures of the father/son duo Pop and Corn, alongside a 3rd boardwalk escapee - Salt Water Taffy. However, when envy starts to brew, Taffy takes matters into her own hands. Styled as a news station broadcast, this lighthearted, comedy film touches upon themes of envy, curiosity, perseverance, and recognizing that wrongdoings can lead to poor fortune.

#### A Shore Thing

Written & Directed by Joe Joyce. Two recently fired Ocean City locals are looking for jobs when they finally land what appears to be the position of their dreams. But what is all this then?

#### One Perfect Show: The Story of Kenny & The Shore Patrol

Directed, Shot, and Edited by Davis Mears. A mockumentary about a cover band in Ocean City called "Kenny & The Shore Patrol" - who played a perfect show back in 1987 and then was never heard from again. The film follows the timeline of events that led to the downfall of the band, and eventually, a possible reunion.

#### Remember Me

Directed by Jackson Dutton and Ashton Kozak. Remember Me is a dark romance based on many real stories. Emily Smith and Joshua Adams are first seen as a happy couple who have just moved int their own house. They enjoy spending time together in Ocean City until disaster strikes. Joshua Adams is suddenly found dead after a big argument between Emily and Himself. Emily is now forced to overcome her recent loss and move forward from this tragedy.

#### 10:30 Adult Lightsaber Training

Ages: 15 - and up

Time: 20 - 30 minutes

Number of Participants: 10

Lightsabers for use in the class will be provided

In the Adult Intro to Lightsaber Choreography class, participants will experience an introductory course to learn the basics of wielding a Lightsaber. Saber Guild's seasoned members will demonstrate a variety of movements and techniques used when learning lightsaber combat choreography. Along with these skills, participants get acquainted with how to use a stunt Lightsaber, handle it safely, and how to work safely with a partner. Participants will learn three established sets that we use in our regular performances and a Force Move. At the conclusion of this training class, we will create a "show off" opportunity for their Lightsaber training archives.

#### 1:45 Kids Lightsaber Training

Lightsabers for use in the class will be provided

The younglings will take their first steps into a larger world during this introductory course to Lightsabers and the Force. Saber Guild's elite Jedi will demonstrate their skills before introducing the younglings to the Force and guiding them through the first form of Lightsaber combat: Shii-Cho. Once the younglings understand this form, the instructors will teach them how to use their lightsaber for defense, showing them basic dodges, blocks, and Force moves to protect themselves from the Empire or the First Order. The younglings might have the chance to use what they have learned against Saber Guild's Sith. At the conclusion of this training class, we will create photo opportunities for parents including a class photo and the younglings will receive a certificate for their studies in Lightsaber training.


